

Trinity Valley School Technology Responsible Use Policy

Grades 3 - 4



At Trinity Valley School, our vision is to enhance and redefine learning through the integration of technology within the curriculum. Students have access to computers and iPads throughout the day. The expectations for the students are that their behavior and language when using technology will follow the same rules established at school. To guide students in displaying positive digital citizenship, responsible use policies have been developed that outline the students' rights and responsibilities.

Responsible Use for All Technology Equipment

1. I will use the computers/iPads only to do school work.
2. I will use the internet only in ways my teacher has approved.
3. I will not use games or other electronic resources that have objectionable content.
4. My password is private and I will not share it with anyone except my parents. I will not ask anyone else for their password.
5. I will **never** share or post my last name, address, phone number, or any other personal information about myself or anyone else while online.
6. I will be polite and considerate when I use the computer. I will **never** post anything online that could be considered bullying behavior or that might be hurtful to another person.
7. I will take good care of the technology equipment and will ask for help if I see a problem. If the problem is inappropriate content, I will turn off the monitor or close the iPad immediately and seek help.
8. I will always be aware of copyright rules and will not take credit for someone else's work.

Responsible Use Specific to iPads

1. I will use **only** the apps/websites that my teachers have instructed me to use.
2. I will make sure all apps are properly closed when I am finished with the iPad.
3. I will know where my iPad is at all times and will make sure it will be used or stored in a safe place. (i.e. Not left on the floor.)
4. I understand that I may not alter the settings or change the wallpaper on the iPad.
5. I will avoid taking photos or video of anyone or anything without permission from a teacher.
6. I will be very careful to avoid deleting another person's work.

I promise to follow these rules. I understand that if I choose to break the rules, I may not be able to use the computers/iPads at school.
