The TVS Community Partners Program (CPP) invites rising 7th-12th graders to participate in this two-week* summer session focused on leadership in the community, learning about local non-profit organizations, and discovering the important roles that philanthropy and service play in strengthening and improving the community in which we live. ***Students should plan to attend both weeks of this two-week program.**

As part of this program, students serve as a philanthropic board of directors and allocate real monetary donations among participating non-profit organizations. This allocation experience is possible through a grant given by the Once Upon a Time Foundation and The Fash Foundation.

This course also includes hands-on service experiences at local non-profit organizations, where students gain first-hand knowledge of how non-profit organizations operate and see how these organizations affect the lives of individuals in our community.

There is no cost for this program, and participants have an amazing opportunity to learn what it takes to be a philanthropic leader and make a difference within the community, but space is limited.
