- _____ 2 highlighters/smaller or thinner size/any color
- _____ 2 Sharpies/black
- _____ 2 wide-ruled one subject notebook (spirals) 70 to 100 count
(*1blue for history, 1red for Spanish*)
- _____ 2 blue-lined graph ruled notebooks (spirals) about 100 sheets (*math*)/try to
get a green or black cover to avoid confusion with above spirals
- _____ 1 2-inch or 3-inch **ZIPPER** binder
(*D rings are great if you can find them, but avoid double-sided zipper binders*)
- _____ 4 dry erase markers (*math*) **NO NEON COLORS**-they do not erase cleanly
- _____ 1 pkg. wide-lined filler paper
- _____ 2 pkgs. 4x4 squares/inch graph paper
- _____ 1 pkg. ruled index cards, 3"x 5" (*history*)
- _____ **Boys**/1 pkg. thick crayola markers
- _____ **Girls**/1 pkg. thin crayola markers/small pack
- _____ 1 composition book/wide-ruled 100 pages *for science*
- _____ 6 poly dividers with pockets and tabs
(*The sturdier plastic dividers work better for fifth graders.*)

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS
